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**Invitation for Bids**

The City of Roma will receive bids for the TDA-TXCDBG (Contract #711409) Paving & Drainage Improvements (La Hacienda & Las Flores) until 3 p.m. on September 11, 2012 at Roma City Hall (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 947, Roma, TX 78584). The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 3 p.m. on September 11, 2012 at Roma City Hall (77 E. Convent Ave, Roma, Texas).

**The project will reconstruct multiple roadways in the La Hacienda and Las Flores subdivisions. Bids are invited for the quantities of work as follows:**

**Approximately 16,000 SY of roadway rehabilitation (includes excavation & embankment, flexible base material, grading, compaction, asphalt prime, and hot mix). The total length of concrete curb & gutter (laydown) to be constructed is approximately 9,000 LF.**

Bid/Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications are on file for examination at Roma City Hall (77 E. Convent Ave, Roma, Texas).

Copies of the Bid/Contract Documents may be obtained by depositing \$ 50.00 with the Project Engineer (Enprotec / Hibbs & Todd, Inc., 402 Cedar Street, Abilene, Texas 79601) for each set of documents obtained. The deposit is not refundable.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Roma or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Department of Labor and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, age or national origin.

The City of Roma reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the City of Roma for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
